## BONUS VACATION

THE GUJARAT government on Monday declared October 30 as a holiday, thus giving a stretch of five days to its employees to celebrate Diwali, impressing upon being an "employee friendly government". October 31 is already a government holiday for Sardar Patel Jayanti, though Prime Minister Narendra Modi is visiting the Statue of Unity site that day. November 1, Friday, will mark Labh Pancham, the fifth day of the Gujarati new year, considered auspicious for businesses establishments to open new accounts. The bonus holiday to enjoy Diwali comes in lieu of November 9, which will now be a working Saturday, said a communication from the General Administration Department. Diwali, an important festival in Gujarat, falls on October 27, followed by the first day of the Gujarati new year and Bhai Beej, both of which (October 28 and 29) are holidays. In any case, nothing remains functional in Gujarat till Labh Pancham. Apart from the employees of the state government in Secretariat, the decision applies to all employees of state government undertakings, boards, corporations and panchayats.

## WHAT TOILETS?

A DAY after a village panchayat block in Sehra taluka of Panchmahals put up hoardings declaring all eight villages under its jurisdiction as Open Defecation Free (ODF) during a 'Seva Setu' program, villagers from as many as three neighbourhoods approached the taluka-level officers claiming that no toilets were built in their villages. In their memorandum, the villagers stated, "If the villages are ODF, then 70 toilets have gone missing from the villages." The revelation has now led to an inquiry being set up by the Mamlatdar. Preliminary investigations revealed that pits were dug for the toilets, but no further work was undertaken. While the pits were counted as 'toilets' for the gram panchayat, the villagers still go out and defecate in the open.

## 6 injured in blast at blower manufacturing company

All the injured have been moved to SSG hospital for treatment.

Those injured have been identified as Bhaskar Nath (36), owner of the company and five

other employees, Khumansinh Bhabhor (32), Subhash Chitre (33), Rajesh Jain (35), Vishwas Soli (37), Srikant Borse (38), Bhabhor and Chitre are said to be in a critical condition.

As per preliminary information, the accident took place after a boiler exploded during a routine testing of the machineries at the company. The said boiler was a part of the machinery being used to extract bio oil from single-use plastic. The machine, with a capacity of 100 litre liquid plastic, exploded due to an increase in pressure created from the vapourised form, fire officials said.

THE TWO crucial assembly seats — Radhanpur and Bayad — that went to bypolls in Gujarat Monday along with four other seats registered a polling percentage of over 61 per cent, much above the state average of 53.68 per cent.

The bypolls were held for Tharad in Banaskantha district, Radhanpur in Patan, Kheralu in Mehsana, Bayad in Arvalli, Amraiwadi in Ahmedabad and Lunawada in Mahisagar district.

The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) had fielded turncoats Alpesh Thakor and Dhavalsinh Zala from Radhanpur and Bayad respectively. The duo joined the BJP after the Rajya Sabha polls in the state earlier this year. In Radhanpur, where the fight was between Alpesh Thakor and Congress rival Raghunath Desai, the polling percentage stood at 62.95 according to the Election Commission figures released at 8 pm. During the 2017 assembly elections, the voting percentage on this seat was 68.64 per cent.

At Bayad, where Zala was pitted against Congress rival Shivabhai Patel, the polling percentage was 61.01, much lower to the 70.88 per cent clocked during the assembly polls in 2017.

The polling percentage for both these seats of Radhanpur and Bayad were higher than the state average of 53.68 per cent. The highest turnout of 68.95 per cent was, however, registered in Tharad in Banaskantha, North Gujarat, while the lowest of 34.75 per cent was registered on the assembly constituency of Amraiwadi in Ahmedabad city.

With over 2.79 lakh voters, Amraiwadi has the highest number of voters among the six assembly seats that went to the

polls in the state on Monday. Polls to the Amraiwadi seat was necessitated after sitting BJP MLA Hasmukh Patel got elected to the Lok Sabha from Ahmedabad East constituency earlier this year. While the ruling BJP has pitched Jagdish Patel, a businessman and director of Ahmedabad-based Pushpak Trademach Limited, from the seat, the Congress has fielded real-estate developer Dharmendra Patel.

The turnout on Kheralu stood at 46.15 per cent and that on Lunawada was 51.23 per cent.

At Nani Hirvani village in Kheralu, police found a man hanging from the fence of a primary school, which was used as a polling booth. The deceased was identified as 20-year-old labourer, Yasant Chauhan. A case of suicide has been registered by Kheralu police, officials said, adding that the incident didn't impact voting process.

## EVMS, VVPATs replaced

"The elections were peaceful in the state," said Dr Murali Krishna, Chief Electoral Officer, Gujarat. On the polling day, some EVMS and VVPATs were also replaced during mock polls. While 22 VVPATs were replaced during the mock polls, an additional 38 VVPATs were replaced while polls were under way.

As far as EVMS are concerned, a total of 5 Ballot Units and 14 Control units were replaced during the mock poll, while an additional 9 Ballot Units and an equal number of Control Units were replaced,

## State has highest number of Pakistani undertrial prisoners in India: NCRB

GUJARAT HAS the highest number of undertrial prisoners who are Pakistani nationals compared to other states, according to crime and prison statistics of 2017 made public by the National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) on Monday. The state has 59 Pakis-tani undertrial prisoners out of the total 101 overseas prisoners in the state, it said.

While the state's statistics show there were 80 undertrial prisoners under the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, the data shows zero convicts under this law in the period covered.

The number of Pakistani undertrials account for nearly 74 per cent of the total 80 undertrials in the state who are foreign nationals. Jammu and Kashmir has the second-highest Pakistani national undertrials at 35, according to the NCRB data.

The foreign nationals in state prisons include 11 from Bangladesh, eight from Nigeria, one from Nepal and one undertrial recorded as "other foreign national". Of the total 21 overseas convicts, seven were recorded to be from Pakistan, two from Africa, other than Nigeria, four from Bangladesh, two from the Middle-East, two from Nepal,

one from Nigeria and three "other foreign nationals".

The data between January 1 and December 31, 2017 shows Gujarat ranking fourth among 29 states in Special and Local Laws (SLL) Crimes. In terms of absolute numbers, 2,06,024 SLL cases were reported in the period, which is a decrease from 3,07,108 cases in 2015. Gujarat's local laws include the liquor prohibition law.

As per the prison statistics, of the total 333 SLL convicts in the state in 2017, only three were convicted under the prohibition of liquor law as on December 31, 2017. With a whopping 770 undertrial prisoners under this Act, the state ranked the highest in this parameter. However, 124 were convicted under the NDPS Act, making it the largest share of the total SLL convicts in the state.

On pardoning of convicts, Gujarat comes second, according to the NCRB. Of the total 258 convicts released under pardon in 2017 across the country, Gujarat pardoned 104, numbering second only after Uttar Pradesh where 140 were pardoned.

The state also has the highest number of prisoners who went absconding while on parole in 2017. The number across the country is 384, of which 156 (nearly 40%) were from Gujarat.
